## **Refugee Week 2017 – Sunday 18 June to Saturday 24 June 2017**

From Father Peter,

Last week I attended a meeting of church leaders, lay and ordained, at Trinity Theological College in Melbourne to discuss how to attract and train those 'laborers' who are called to work in the Lord's vineyard, with a special focus on those called to the ordained ministry. In spite of our contemporary culture which is often indifferent

and at times even hostile to the Church and the Gospel it proclaims, women and men are still hearing God's call to ordained ministry and offering themselves for God's service. We need to pray that the Lord will keep sending laborers into his vineyard. As well, we need to give ongoing support to our places of ministerial formation, in this case Trinity Theological College, which is the official Theological College for the Melbourne Diocese and the Province of Victoria. The main annual fundraiser is the Archbishop's Dinner held in the Trinity College Dining Room, this year on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> August. Once again, we will get together a table from the parish to support this vital dimension of Church life. It's a fun night for a worthy cause. Please consider being a part of it.
