From Father Peter,

This week, once again, St Peter illustrates our shared humanity and the inherent frailties we carry. This time, finding that the good we seek is not always so good after all.

Someone said once that the most damning epitaph of all is “he meant well” or equally unflattering, “his heart was in the right place”. This is St Peter when he tries to do the right thing, but it turns out not to be so. When Jesus names the deadly risk surrounding them Peter’s advice is, ‘Let’s get out of here’. The fact that Jesus found his words a ‘stumbling block’ indicates that Peter’s well-meaning intervention landed as a temptation for Jesus. Jesus himself had to do a reality check on his own heart. He was sufficiently in touch with his own heart to discern what was really happening at a spiritual level. In his famous words he addresses not only Peter, but the negative spiritual influence that is leading Peter away from that which is good and true: “Get thee behind me satan”. Like Peter, we can follow our hearts down the wrong track, the important thing is to grow in self-knowledge and in the art of discerning the movements of our own heart. In this way we will make better choices in the ordinariness of our day to day lives.
