4th Tranche of parish records lodged with the Diocesan Archives

Background:

On 1st March 2023 the large parish safe in the vicarage at St James' Point Lonsdale was emptied of all records in preparation for its removal, pending the occupancy of the vicarage by the new incumbent. All current registers (Baptisms, Confirmations, Marriages and Funerals) were relocated to the current Parish Office at the front of the Vicarage. All other Registers, dating from 1857 including faculties and sundry documents, were removed to the Parish History Project Room in Gill Hall at St James and placed in filing cabinet number 4, drawers C and D. This was carried out by Carole Barwick and Lindsay Howe.

Below is a list of the registers and other items along with their searchable Digital Record Numbers. Almost all the non-current records on the list have been digitised over the last five years and are available for viewing on computers in the History Project Room and possibly in the future via the Parish Home Page. The exceptions are the last items on this list - St George's Queenscliff and St James' Point Lonsdale Registers of Services (which were not deemed important enough to digitise).

Proposal:

Over the last four years, with Parish Council's agreement, three collections of Parish records have been lodged with the Diocese of Melbourne Anglican Archives repository in North Fitzroy for safekeeping. These are known as Tranches 1, 2 and 3.

The History Team propose to Parish Council that all the non-current records removed from the safe should now be transferred to Anglican Archives as Tranche 4.

It is a condition of lodgement that records can be removed and/or returned to the Parish at the request of the Parish Council at any time by arrangement. Original documents may be viewed at the repository by arrangement with their staff.
