Isaiah 50:4-9a

The Lord God has given me
the tongue of a teacher,
that I may know how to sustain
the weary with a word.

Morning by morning he wakens—
wakens my ear
to listen as those who are taught.

⁵The Lord God has opened my ear,
and I was not rebellious,
I did not turn backwards.

⁶I gave my back to those who struck me,
and my cheeks to those who pulled out the beard;
I did not hide my face
from insult and spitting.

⁷The Lord God helps me;
therefore I have not been disgraced;
therefore I have set my face like flint,

and I know that I shall not be put to shame;
⁸ he who vindicates me is near.
Who will contend with me?
Let us stand up together.
Who are my adversaries?
Let them confront me.
⁹ It is the Lord God who helps me;
who will declare me guilty?

Have mercy upon me, O Lord, for I am in trouble:

My eye wastes away for grief, my throat also and my inward parts.

For my life wears out in sorrow, and my year with sighing:

My strength fails me in my affliction, and my bones are consumed.

And my neighbours wag their heads in derision.

And those that see me in the street shrink from me.

I am forgotten like one dead and out of mind:

I have become like a broken vessel.

For I hear the whispering of many:

And fear is on every side;

While they plot together against me:

And scheme to take away my life.
